Foreword

Each year, The Coaches & Mentors Program, funded by the Carl Perkins Vocational and Technical Education Grant, conducts an annual survey of Cape Cod Community College graduates. The survey is conducted approximately ten months after graduation to determine the educational and/or employment status of each graduate. This instrument also allows us to measure and document the effectiveness of our career programs and to communicate this information to the Massachusetts Department of Education. The following 2005 graduates were surveyed in the spring of 2006 to determine their educational and/or employment status:

- all associate in arts graduates
- all associate in science graduates
- students completing certificate programs that contain at least one academic component/course and two or more career courses totaling 12 or more credits

In an effort to obtain the 65% state mandated minimum response rate, 2005 graduates were contacted through two mailings and asked to self-report on both their educational and employment status. The initial mailing was sent early in April 2006 and was followed up by a second mailing to all non-respondents in June 2006. A follow-up telephone survey was conducted in September. **In addition, this year's transfer data information was also collected through EnrollmentSearch from the National Student Clearinghouse Program.**

In some cases, graduates provided incomplete information, such as failing to report their present employer or transfer institution. This information is listed in the following report as "undisclosed" or "unknown." Various faculty members were also consulted to provide additional information that could not be obtained from the graduates themselves.

A copy of the survey instrument is included in this booklet for your perusal.

Prior to reviewing this report, please note the following:

- all percentages are based on the number of graduates responding
- survey data reported in this booklet is based on information collected as of November 2006
- all associate in arts concentrations are reported together under one heading
- for the purpose of this report, for all associate in science programs, a positive placement is defined as securing employment in a field related to their major (32 hours or more), pursuing additional education or entering the military
- some programs did not graduate students in 2005 and, therefore, are not included in this report
- programs without respondents are **not** included in this report

It is our hope that this report will serve as a multipurpose instrument, whether it be for marketing a specific program, advising students, gathering historical information, or exploring career options with students entering the job market.
