1. **Course Number: BIT260**
Course Title: Information Technology Field Project
2. **Description:** Students have a practical, hands-on experience developing a real-world computer application. This course must be taken in conjunction with an advanced level IT course. One hour per week of consultation with the assigned faculty member. A minimum of 15 hours of independent work.
3. **Student Learning Outcomes (instructional objectives & intellectual skills):** During this course, students do the following:
 - Learn or enhance an IT skill
 - Apply classroom knowledge to real tasks in a working IT environment.
4. **Credits:** 1 credit; May be repeated once.
5. **Satisfies General Education Requirement:** No
6. **Prerequisites:** Permission of IT Coordinator
7. **Semester(s) Offered:** Varies
8. **Suggested General Guidelines for Evaluation:** Each student will be assigned a project to be completed independently. The student will be required to track the project using project management software, report activity (number of hours on the project) and to meet regularly with the assigned faculty member to review the progress on the project. Intellectual skills include logic, reasoning, critical thinking, and written and oral communication.
