

Cape Cod Community College Opportunity For Public Comment On Reaccreditation

Cape Cod Community College will undergo a comprehensive evaluation visit April, 23-25, 2018 by a team representing the Commission on Institutions of Higher Education of the New England Association of Schools and Colleges.

The Commission is recognized by the U.S. Department of Education and accredits approximately 240 institutions in New England. Cape Cod Community College had been accredited by the Commission since 1967 and was last reviewed in 2008. Its accreditation encompasses the entire institution.

Over the past year and a half, Cape Cod Community College has conducted a self-study of its own effectiveness, addressing the Commission's *Standards for Accreditation*. A team of peer evaluators will visit the institution to gather evidence that the self-study is thorough and accurate. The team will recommend to the Commission a continuing status for the institution. Following a review process, the Commission will take the final action.
